

BIOGRAPHY

Jeffrey T. Liegner, M.D. was born and raised in and around Newton, New Jersey, the third child of Dr. Frank and Rosemary Liegner. He received his degree in physics from Duke University under an Air Force ROTC Scholarship, and then performed four years of active duty in Texas as a research physicist.

Dr. Liegner completed his medical degree at the University of Texas Health Science Center (UTHSC) in San Antonio while also receiving a Master's degree in biology under a separate academic program during the first two years of medical school training. He interned in Internal Medicine at the University-affiliated County and Veteran's Hospitals in San Antonio, and subsequently completed a residency in Ophthalmology at UTHSC in 1992.

After five years in private practice in Oregon, he moved to northern New Jersey in 1997. He has continued his Air Force duty as a reservist, flight surgeon and physicist, and holds the rank of Lieutenant Colonel.

Dr. Liegner is married with three boys, and the family lives in Fredon Township just outside Newton.

He is fully Board certified by the American Board of Ophthalmology and is on the medical staff of Newton Memorial Hospital. He is also a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons, the most prestigious surgical affiliation offered only after extensive training and demonstrated surgical skill.

Holding several leadership positions within the American Academy of Ophthalmology, Dr. Liegner is active in the National Association for Parents of the Visually Impaired (NAPVI), the American Foundation for the Blind (AFB), and the National Federation of the Blind (NFB), for whom he often provides informative lectures on ophthalmic concerns.

He has served by legislative appointment to the Board of Directors for the State's Commission for the Blind. Part of his past responsibilities also included regularly performing duty as Physician for the Day to the elective representatives during legislative sessions. For many years, he has taught ophthalmology to young physicians at the state's medical school.

SERVICES

Dr. Liegner offers complete and routine eye care for adult and pediatric patients, including routine eyeglass refractions and contact lens fittings.

Procedural expertise includes refractive laser vision surgery (LASIK), cataract surgery through a very small incision ("no stitch"), eye muscle surgery, lacrimal drainage surgery for excessive tearing, complete medical, laser and surgical care for glaucoma, diabetic retinopathy and other medical retinal problems, plastic surgery around the eyes, children's eye care, corneal disease and transplants, and traumatic repair of eye and eyelid injuries.

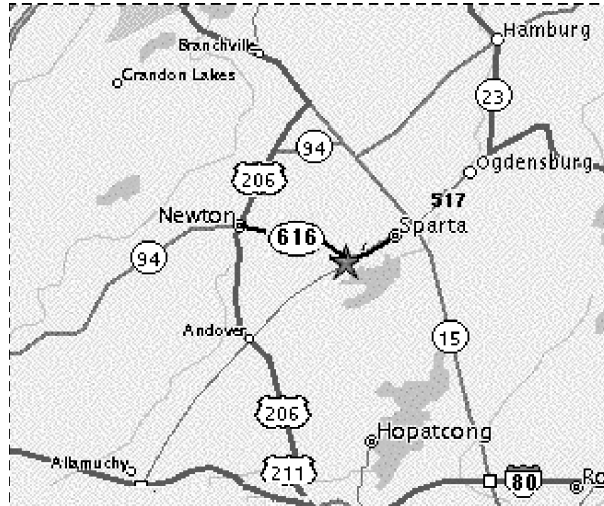
The office location is at 350 Sparta Avenue (on the second floor of building A) and includes an Ambulatory Surgical Center for onsite same-day outpatient surgery without hospitalization.

He is also skilled in providing low vision rehabilitation services to patients with significant visual impairments, assisting individuals in coping with sight loss to maintain independence.
